

ALPHA OMEGA ALPHA MEDICAL STUDENT SERVICE PROJECT AWARD

Purpose: To aid the establishment or expansion of a medical student service project benefiting the medical school or the local community, and to recognize students who dedicate their time and effort to these endeavors. Only one proposal will be accepted from each school during an academic year.

Eligibility: Any medical student or group of students at a school with an active AQA chapter. AQA membership is not required.

The award: The school will receive up to \$2000 per year, renewable for a second year up to \$1000 and a third year up to \$500 to fund the project. Funding for the second and third years will be dependent on review by the national office of a progress report on the first year.

Dates: Applications will be accepted by the national office at any time.

Proposal requirements:

1. Proposals describing the project and the involvement of the organizing student(s) should be prepared by the involved student(s).
2. Each application must include an explanation of the project's goals and objectives, a proposed budget, and plans for evaluation. The application should be limited to two single-spaced pages (1-inch margins, 10-point or larger type).

Next steps:

1. Proposals will be reviewed and approved by the AQA councilor and the dean's office. The dean and the AQA councilor will provide letters of support to accompany the proposal.
2. The proposal will be sent to the national office for evaluation. Within 30 days of receipt, the national office will notify the student(s) and the school of its decision regarding funding.
