March 2

Fellow in Leadership

Recognizes and supports the development of outstanding mid-career physicians aspiring to be future leaders.

April 3

Robert J. Glaser Distinguished Teacher Award

Recognizes four faculty members at LCME-accredited medical schools: two educators from basic science, preclinical departments, and two from clinical disciplines.

The Alpha Omega Alpha (AΩA) Robert J. Glaser Distinguished Teacher Awards were established by the AΩA Honor Medical Society in 1988 to provide national recognition to faculty members who have distinguished themselves in medical student education.

Recipients are recognized at the annual Association of American Medical Colleges Awards Dinner.

May 29

Postgraduate Fellowship

Provides residents and fellows with funding for research or scholarly projects in the spirit of the AΩA mission. Priority is given to projects that include elements of leadership, professionalism, and teaching.

September 30

AΩA Award for Excellence in Inclusion, Diversity, and Equity in Medical Education and Patient Care

Recognizes medical schools (and their associated AΩA Chapter) that demonstrate exemplary leadership, innovation, and engagement in fostering an inclusive culture that transforms the ideals of inclusion, diversity, and equity into successful programs that support medical student, house staff, and faculty diversity in service to the community.

October 2

AΩA Professionalism Award

Recognizes programs in medical schools or other institutions that represent best practices in the teaching and learning of medical professionalism. Individuals or teams may apply. Programs should include students, residents, faculty, and other health care team members; show evidence of effectiveness; show evidence of sustainability; and be exportable to other medical institutions.

October 16

Robert H. Moser Essay Award

Honors the late Robert H. Moser, MD (AΩA, Georgetown University, 1969) by selecting and publishing an outstanding essay celebrating the life of a physician who has enriched the world through his/her career in medicine.
